



Delivery of the curriculum shall foster student progress and achievement, meet all board expectations and legislative requirements, and reflect the special character of the school. Therefore the principal must ensure:

1. achievement of the Charter aims and targets
2. compliance with the National Administration Guidelines
3. the Religious Education programme as required by the Catholic Bishops of New Zealand is taught
4. there is a focus on the national priority groups of Maori, Pasifika and students with special learning needs in school planning and reporting
5. that board approval is sought before changes to the school curriculum requiring increased expenditure or significant changes to programmes or staffing are made
